Petrophysics Summer School

Petrophysics is the study of the physical (and chemical) properties of rocks and their interactions with fluids. It integrates in situ downhole logging data with core and seismic data. This has significant applications in the hydrocarbon industry in terms of both exploration for, and production of, oil and gas. It is also an important component of the International Ocean Discovery Program (IODP) in helping to answer the many and varied questions posed by ocean research drilling expeditions around the world. This third Petrophysics Summer School will provide a unique workshop that will bring together experts from both academia and industry to give training in the theory and practice of petrophysics, with real world case studies from across both IODP and industry. It will include lectures, discussion groups, and practical exercises on the different elements and data types used in petrophysical analysis. In addition, basic training in an industry-standard software package, Schlumberger's Techlog, will form a core part of the school.

The European Consortium for Ocean Research Drilling (ECORD) will sponsor **10 to 15 Scholarships** to allow outstanding young scientists to attend one of the three 2018 **ECORD Summer Schools** in **Urbino (Italy)**, **Bremen (Germany)** or **Leicester (UK)**. The Scholarships will contribute to costs of registration, travel, subsistence and/or accommodation at the Schools.

The ECORD Scholarships are open to young scientists based in ECORD countries (see <http://www.ecord.org/about-ecord/about-us/> for a list of ECORD countries).

Preference will be given to PhD students or early career post-doctoral research scientists. The review of the applications will be made by ESSAC, the ECORD Science Committee, and the decisions will be communicated by the end May 2018.

**The deadline to apply for an ECORD Scholarship is 30 April 2018.**

Applications should be sent to the ESSAC Office ([essac@plymouth.ac.uk](mailto:essac@plymouth.ac.uk)) and should include a detailed **Letter of Interest** (max. two pages), a **CV** and a **Letter of Support** from one supervisor. The most important document of the package is the Letter of Interest, which should outline the motivation for your application and summarise how attendance at the summer school will be beneficial for your future scientific career.
