CALL FOR APPLICATIONS AND NOMINATIONS

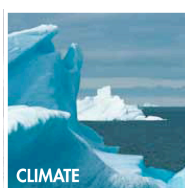

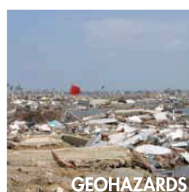

How it works: As soon as the lecturers are selected, institutions across Europe and Canada will be invited to apply to host a lecture by one of the speakers. ESSAC will assist the lecturers in putting together a programme for the period given above. Each lecturer will be expected to deliver at least **six talks** during their term as Distinguished Lecturer. Travel costs will be provided by ESSAC. The host institutions are asked to provide accommodation and meals for the Distinguished Lecturers and to meet any other local costs associated with hosting the speaker.

Applications: The ECORD Science Support & Advisory Committee (ESSAC) is now inviting nominations of lecturers, including self-nominations, for this exciting programme. Applications for the 2018/2019 schedule should be made by email (with 'DLP Application' in the subject line) to the ESSAC Office at essac@plymouth.ac.uk. If you are nominating yourself please attach your current **CV (1-2 pages)**. If you are nominating a third party, please first establish their willingness to participate and then ask them to send us their CV directly. Applicants should indicate a **draft title** for their proposed lecture, which should be **strongly linked to IODP science**.
