New JRFB members will serve three-year terms beginning on October 1, 2019. Letters should clearly indicate your primary field of expertise, briefly document any previous committee experience, describe your interest in the scientific ocean drilling programs, and identify your preferred panel or committee assignments.

Candidates for the JRFB should have an extensive history of participation in scientific ocean drilling.
