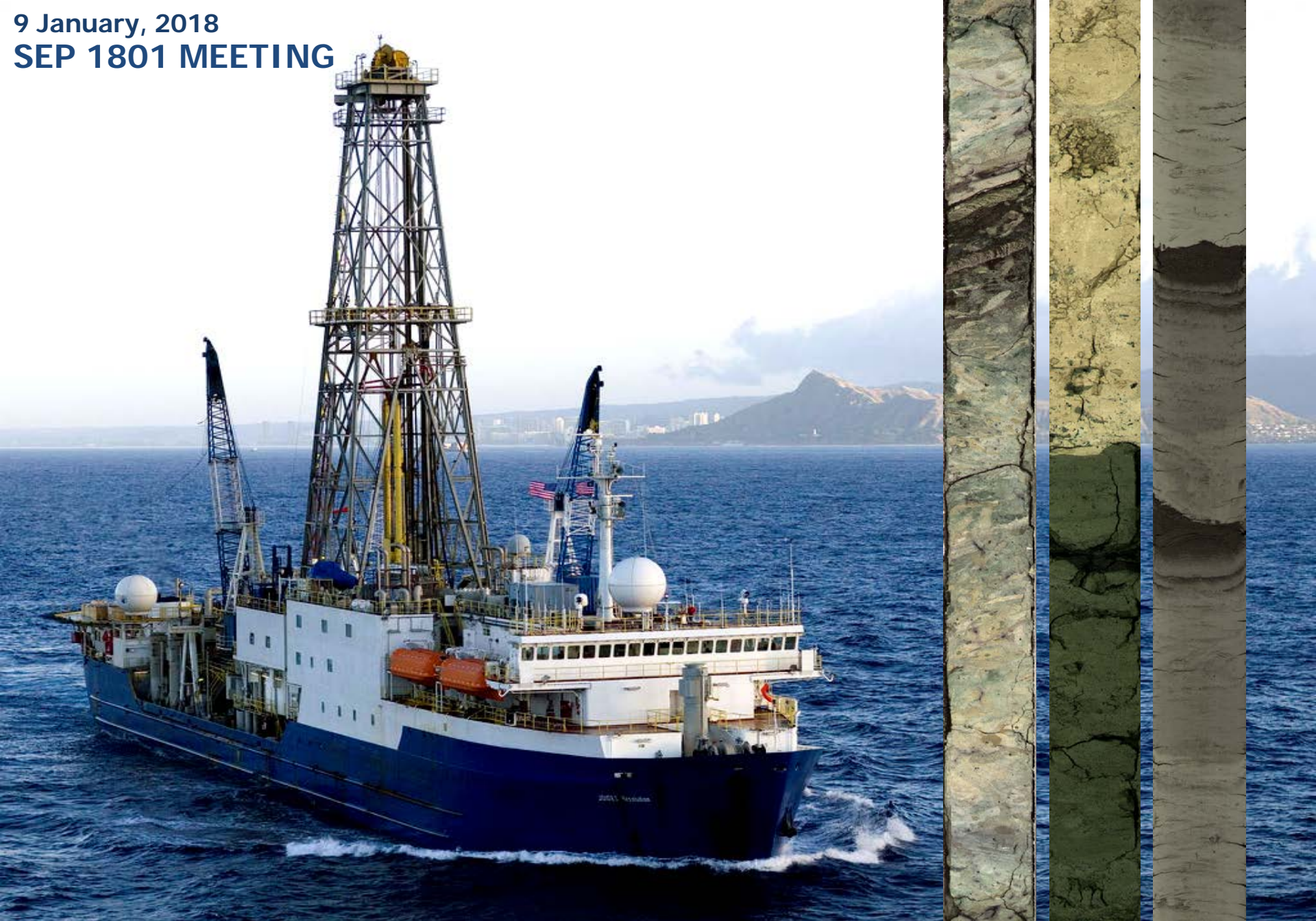

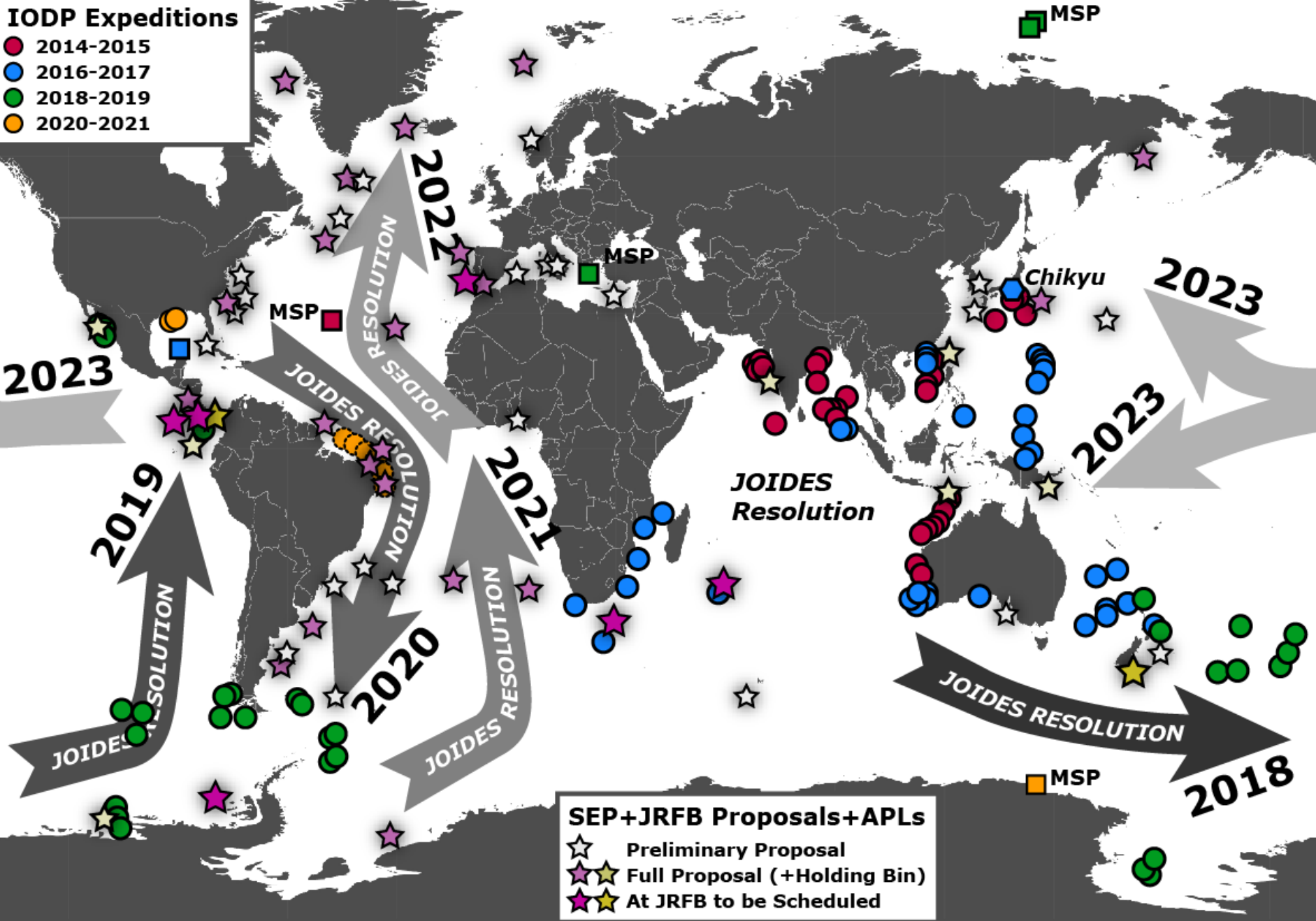

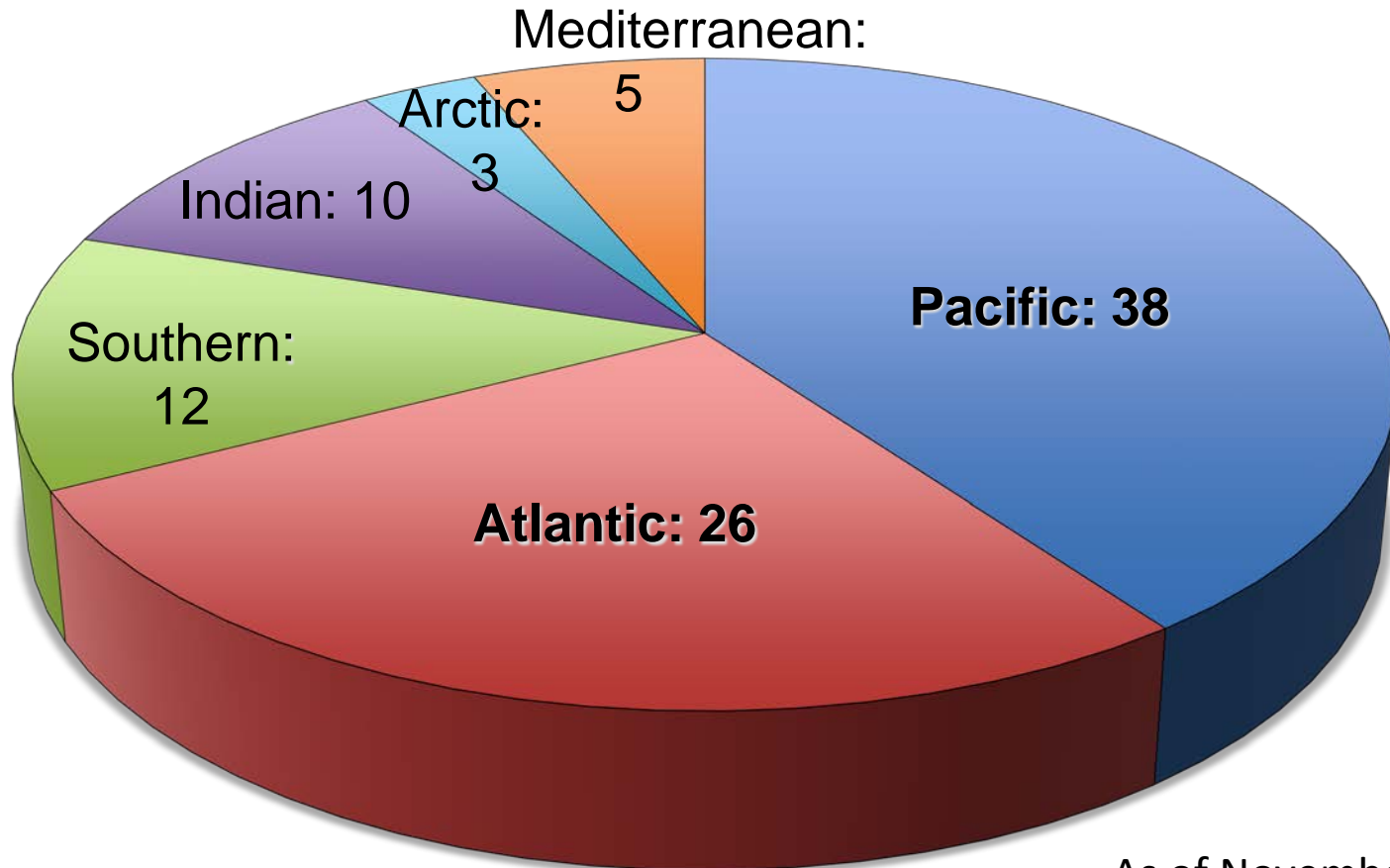

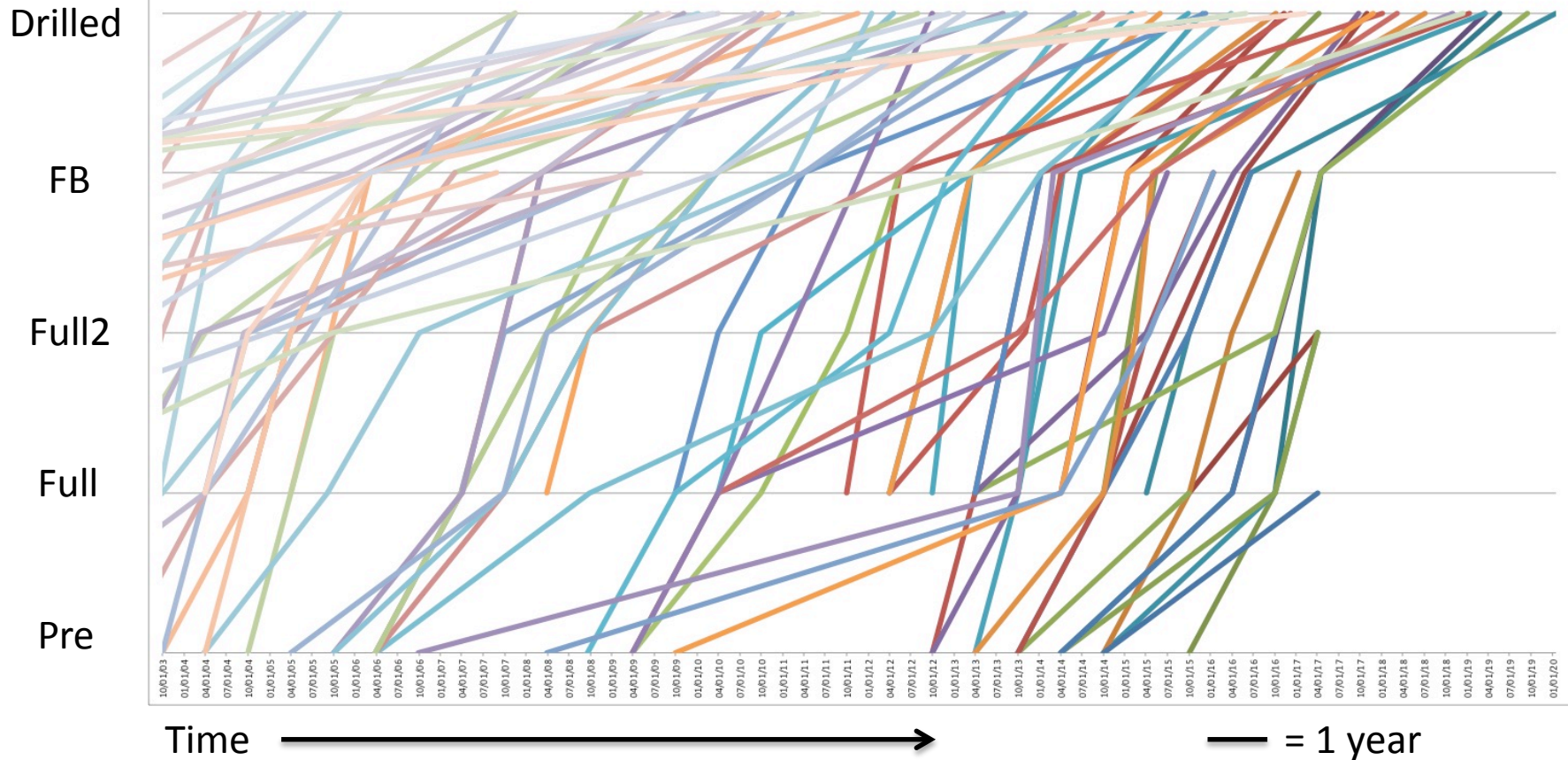
Active proposal status: 95 by target ocean

Significantly reduced proposal review timeline from 7-10 to 3-4 years

The MagellanPlus Workshop Series Programme is co-funded by ECORD and ICDP and designed to support scientists in developing new and innovative science proposals to meet future challenges in Earth, life and environmental sciences. For this purpose the MagellanPlus Workshop Series Programme funds workshops and/or scientists that are expected to lead to or foster high-quality and innovative scientific drilling proposals for submission to IODP and ICDP.

Proposals are reviewed by the MagellanPlus Steering Committee (MSC), with the advice of external reviewers where applicable. Proponents will be notified of the outcome within two months following the submission deadline.

Proposals should follow the themes of the IODP and ICDP Science Plans and will include complete and realistic scripts for the proposed workshop. A funded workshop must be executed within 12 months after notification of funding. A typical workshop is expected to take place over 2-4 days, and have 20-35 participants. The workshop should be located in an ECORD country, close to a convenient air and/or train hub and have relatively low-cost facilities.

In addition to workshop funding, the MagellanPlus Workshop Series Programme support the **participation of ECORD and ICDP scientists in international IODP and ICDP workshops** held in other countries. There is no call so proposals for these funds and a request should be submitted by the organisers of the workshop to Lucas Lourens (Chair of MagellanPlus). The proposal will briefly describe the workshop's aims, agenda and setting and will include a list of ECORD/ICDP member country scientists to be supported, with their CV and motivations to attend the workshop. Travel support will not exceed 1,500 € per scientist.

Call for proposals

The **ECORD/ICDP MagellanPlus Workshop Series Programme** offers financial support to organise a **2- or 3-day workshop directed at the development of IODP, ICDP and/or amphibious drilling proposals** that follow from the major themes of the IODP and ICDP science plans:

- Earth's Surface Environmental Change, Processes and Effects;
- The Deep Biosphere & Sub-Sea-floor Ocean*;
- Solid Earth Cycles & Geodynamics.

**Proposals in the theme Deep Biosphere Frontiers are particularly welcome!*

The contribution of the MagellanPlus Workshop Series will not exceed 15,000 Euros per workshop. Proponents are encouraged to seek co-funding from other sources. Workshops will be held no later than 12 months after approval by the MagellanPlus Science Steering Committee.

Proposals must include:

- 1)** Short summary (max 500 characters) stating the purpose of the proposed workshop, its location and expected impact;
- 2)** Full description (max 2 pages) of the proposed workshop outlining the purpose, rationale, expected impact and number of participants;
- 3)** Preliminary workshop programme;
- 4)** List of keynote speakers;
- 5)** Full budget for the workshop;
- 6)** CV (max. 1 page) plus a list of international, peer-reviewed publications for the last five years, of main applicant.

Proposals must be submitted as a single, combined pdf-document and email attachment to **magellan.plus@uu.nl**

The deadline for applications is **15 January 2018**.
